# Missions and Chess

Chess helps the player to analyse and solve problems; enhance children's mental capabilities and mathematical skills.

In the Middle East are millions of refugees in refugee camps. Their children do not have the privilege of schooling which will lead to generations of illiterate people.

In collaboration with people from the local church we started a program to make chess available to the children of refugees in one of the Middle Eastern countries. The chess handbook I have written, is in the process of being translated into Arabic. We are also planning to take small lathes to the area that can be used to make chess sets. One of the local government ministers asked us to send a permanent coach and supply them with 1 000 chess sets.

Giving children hope also rubs off on their parents and more people get to know about the Good News of Jesus Christ. Our chess handbook is also used by a missionary teacher in another Middle Eastern country. By helping children the message is spreading.

Locally we started chess in schools in the Karoo, Natal and Gauteng, and supplied chess sets to town libraries. In the Karoo some children walked more than 10 kilometres to play chess in town libraries. Ekurhuleni has supplied all their town libraries with chess sets now. Once a week we coach free of charge in some of these libraries.

A chess set and board currently cost R120. On request, we can give donors the names of the children their donation provided a chess set for.

# **Interactive Bible Discovery (IBD)**

More than 80% of the world's population DOESN'T READ. Therefore they are considered oral learners. This also includes literate people.

The IBD Training Programme equips literate people to teach oral learners how to personally study the Word of God. The ultimate purpose is to equip these people to be obedient disciples of the Lord Jesus and to involve them in reaching the world with the Gospel.

IBD Trainers guide literate people to understand how oral thinkers learn and teach them how to become involved with

oral communities. Story telling is one of the means used to create an interactive Bible discovery.

During the last 3 years 1400 people in 24 countries (including South Africa) were equipped as practitioners, facilitators and master trainers to be disciple makers and church planters. The focus groups are unreached and unengaged people.

#### CONTENT OF THE IBD PROGRAMME


- Module 1 Oral thinking and teaching strategy

The afternoon of the concert a tremendous storm started raging which carried on into the evening. The wind was so strong that the municipality decided to cancel the concert! This concert never took place.
