Pray that FEBC listeners among these groups will persevere in faith and hope, and that God will bring His light into their hearts.	3 Pray for the UNREACHED YAGNOB people in Tajikistan. They are Sunni Muslims who believe that the supreme God, Allah, determines their eternal salvation, but he is distant. They depend on the spirit world for daily needs. No believers. Pray for encounters with believers.	4 FANDA in Sudan. The Fanda are entirely Muslim. Few, if any, know a Christian in this country where Christians are considered enemies. Pray that this people group recognize their own spiritual bankruptcy and come to Christ for the riches of His forgiveness and salvation.	5 ALUO in China. No known Christians. The Aluo's identity as a people is deeply rooted in their reverence for a legendary hero, Ah-luo, making it very difficult for them to break free and accept Christ. Pray for the Aluo to become a light to the world reflecting Jesus.	6 SAAWE has an exhibition at the NG Wonderboompoort Missions Conference. Pray that many people will visit the exhibition, receive a fresh vision for missions, and become involved in God's work among the nations. Pray for a movement of prayer in the congregation.
7 SAAWE exhibition at the NG Wonderboompoort Missions Conference. Pray for meaningful conversations with those who visit the exhibition and for open hearts to a new understanding of the urgency of world missions, and the many unreached nations.	8 Our team meets today with a long agenda. Pray for us as we seek the Lord's guidance for the planning of the prayer camp, board meeting and the 50th year anniversary. Pray for Lissie who handles the registrations for the prayer camp, and Marie who organizes the anniversary.	9 "SAT-7 is indeed a television station, but I like to call it a beacon, because it spreads the Word of Truth throughout the Arab world and beyond." Pray that many more people in the Arab-speaking world will see the light of Christ through the programs of SAT-7.	10 JAKUN in Malaysia: 36 000. They practice ethnic religions, no known Christians. The Jakun witchdoctor is more powerful than the village chief. Pray that many accept the Lord's invitation to become part of His kingdom and join His great feast at the end of the age.	11 SAAWE has an exhibition at the Missions Expo hosted by the EG Congregation Pretoria East. Pray for meaningful conversations, new contacts, and that the Lord will touch hearts to serve Him in missions. Pray hearts will be touched to become intercessors for nations.	12 SAAWE exhibition at the Missions Expo by the EG Congregation Pretoria East. Pray for good attendance and that many will visit the exhibitions. Pray for all the agencies that exhibit to explain their ministries clearly to those who attend.	13 SAAWE exhibition at the NG Wonderboompoort Missions Conference. Pray that many people will visit the exhibition, receive a fresh vision for missions, and become involved in God's work among the nations. Pray for hearts to be touched for the unreached nations.
14 PINJARA in India. 3,8 million. Although the Pinjaras are Muslim, they celebrate Hindu festivals, making vows to Hindu gods. Pray for the Holy Spirit to stir hunger for God in their heart. Pray for a spiritual hunger that will lead them into a movement to Christ.	15 SAN CHAY in Vietnam. 261 000 Spirit worship is essential to their worldview. Very few have had exposure to the Gospel. Pray for them to submit to Jesus Christ and experience the abundant life He offers in John 10:10. Pray for a thriving church planting movement among them.	16 KYERONG in Nepal, ethnically Tibetan. 4 000. They make up a significant portion of the Tibetans in Nepal. They are Buddhists. Pray that this people group comes to understand that the wisdom, power and goodness of God are found only in Jesus Christ.	17 KHALPA in India. 126 000. They practice Hinduism. Pray for the Lord to raise up Khalpas who crave truth and righteousness enough to embrace Christ no matter what the cost. Pray for hundreds to be discipled in Christ's ways, and that they will teach others.	18 SAAWE Board Meeting. Pray for God's wisdom, unity, and discernment for every board member as important decisions are made. Pray for Thembi who is the chairperson of the board. Pray for sensitive hearts to the guidance and prompting of the Holy Spirit.	19 MATPA in Bhutan. 21 000. Bhutan is a Buddhist Kingdom. Please pray for all the people groups of Bhutan, that the Lord will send the knowledge of the truth about Jesus, to them with great power. Pray for the Lord to pave the way for gospel outreach among the Matpa	20 RAJAKA DOBI in India. 13 million. There are few or no Christ followers among them. Pray for God to raise up Dhobi Christians who will disciple others. Pray that they will hear the gospel and discover that Jesus Christ can wash away their sins and give eternal life.
21 RAJPUT in India. 49 million. Rajputs are proud of their history of conquest, bravery and military might. They need the humility to recognize their need for a Saviour. Pray that they will see the value of becoming part of God's royal family.	22 GANE in Indonesia. 11 000. The Gane confess Islam as their religion. None has bowed the knee to Christ. Pray for loving, anointed workers to go to the Gane. Ask the Lord to spiritually awaken Gane through dreams and visions of the risen Christ.	23 KORAMA in India. 231 000. No believers. Their literacy level is low, so the gospel needs to be given in oral, visual, or auditory form. Pray for spiritual openness that will lead many to faith in Christ.. Pray for an interest in literacy, taught by Christians.	24 LAO LOM in Thailand. 29 000. As Buddhists, the Lao Lom believe in a complicated array of spirits. Pray for signs and wonders among them and for great breakthroughs with a rapid multiplication of disciples and house churches	25 SAAWE Prayer Camp at Cyara Lodge, Hekpoort. Pray that this weekend will be a time of spiritual renewal, close fellowship, and focused intercession for the unreached peoples, the persecuted Church, and SAAWE's ministry.	26 SAAWE Prayer Camp at Cyara Lodge, Hekpoort. Pray for all the prayer sessions today to be Holy Spirit inspired. Pray for all who will share and lead the participants in prayer. Pray for hearts to be touched to become intercessors for the unreached.	27 SAAWE Prayer Camp at Cyara Lodge, Hekpoort. Pray that all campers will come to understanding the suffering of persecuted believers, and our responsibility to pray for them. We are all part of the same body.
28 SAYYID in India. 16,4 million. They are one of the largest and most influential Muslim communities across South Asia. The risk of losing honor, community trust, and influence makes the cost of discipleship feel almost impossible. Pray strong leaders will meet Jesus, and worship the Father in spirit and in truth.	29 BAHA BUYANG in China. 700. Small people group. No believers. Ethnic religions. Ask God to send bold workers, driven by the Holy Spirit, to go to them. Pray they listen to God's message and believe in the good news of their salvation. Pray for an unstoppable movement to Christ	30 KAPARIYA in India. 27 000. They are Hindus, living in North India where it is very dark spiritually. There are few if any near the Kaparias who believe in the only Saviour.
