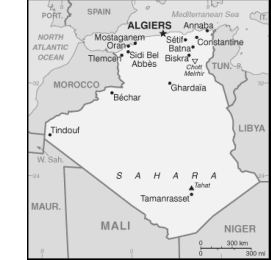


WESTERN SAHARA	
Population: 588 000; Religion: Muslim 99,9%, Christian 0,01% Unreached: 100% of total population	
DID YOU KNOW? Western Sahara is overwhelmingly an Islamic territory, with over 99% of the population adhering to Sunni Islam . The region's religious practices are deeply intertwined with its nomadic history, heavily featuring traditional practices. There are only a small handful of Christians among the entire Sahrawi people of Western Sahara, but we see a new day of growth and witness through low-key mission work and national believers. There are openings for ministry to refugees through relief and development, and difficult political and living conditions lead to considerable openness. The New Testament, JESUS film, and a number of audio resources are available in Hassaniya Arabic. Pray for those who are, and could be, serving among them. Many have been imprisoned due to the conflict with Morocco.	 Taken from Worldometers.info

MOROCCO (nr 23 on WWL)	
Population: 38,5 million; Religion: Muslim 99%, Christian 0,2% Unreached: 99% of total population	
DID YOU KNOW? Morocco's monarchy claims descent from the Prophet Muhammad. Despite being increasingly influenced by the West, Morocco retains a strong Islamic identity, making it dangerous for anyone who chooses to follow Jesus, particularly young people. A massive challenge for Christians, both Moroccan and foreign, is that it is illegal to "shake the faith of a Muslim". That means that any conversation about faith can be fraught with risk, potentially leading to arrest. Converts can encounter intense pressure to renounce their faith, with tactics including isolation, expulsion, violence and even superstitious treatments by imams (Muslim leaders). Converts can lose their jobs. Even if some judges do uphold the cases of converts in court, family pressures can often render their verdicts irrelevant. ALGERIA (nr 20 on WWL)	
Population: 48 million; Religion: Muslim 97%, Christian 0,3% Unreached: 99% of total population	
DID YOU KNOW? Over the past three years, state pressure on Protestant Christians has intensified to levels unseen in decades. Authorities have kept previously closed churches shut and ordered others to cease. As a result, all 47 churches under the Evangelical Protestant Church of Algeria (EPA) have halted their activities, and other independent churches have also stopped meeting due to fear of government action. These closures have strongly increased isolation among Algerian Christians, who are mainly converts from Islam. In addition to church closures, more than 50 Christians have been prosecuted in recent years, with some receiving suspended prison sentences and fines. Converts continue to face strong opposition from families and communities, especially in rural, conservative and Arab regions where pressure and dangers are particularly acute. TUNISIA (nr 31 on WWL)	
Population: 12 million Religion: Muslim 99,4% Christian 0,2% Unreached: 99% of total population	
DID YOU KNOW? Continued economic decline and unemployment, the increasing presence of Islamic fundamentalism, and a heavy-handed President all serve to rob Tunisians of confidence in their country's future. Christians in Tunisia are subject to increasing surveillance by the authorities. Believers who are monitored can be arrested and questioned, and have their homes searched. For the first time, authorities made unprecedented arrests of foreign Christians. They falsely use "human trafficking" charges to justify harassment. Many of these believers have lost their jobs, faced racial abuse from their communities, or have fled. Due to hostility, Tunisian converts feel forced to conceal their faith, leading to isolation as they're unable to gather for worship and mutual support.	 Taken from Worldometers.info
Please pray : - As protests continue against the one-party rule, pray that God would bring about freedom for His people in Tunisia to practise their faith. - Ask God to protect converts from Islam, as they often face substantial persecution. Pray for courage and strength. - That Tunisian followers of Jesus would find fellowship and grow in discipleship, as they often aren't allowed to worship freely. - For persecutors to meet Jesus. <i>"Worship the Lord in the splendor of His holiness; tremble before Him, all the earth.
